
The Goal

The goal with Midnight Remainder is to create a twiceweekly podcast that goes up on Wednesdays and Saturdays, and covers popular topics, personal topics, and topical subjects with the intent of unifying opposed to pandering or targetting a specific type of person. Anything from video games to recent politic events may be covered, but in a manner and mood that makes sense and translates well no matter what the subject of the episode is. Midnight Remainder puts an emphasis on remaining Topical, Unifying, and Respectful.




of podcast listening is done at home



of listening is done in the car




Key podcast listener characteristics: LOYAL, EDUCATED, AFFLUENT




Podcast Listeners by Gender





ANT-MAN AND THE WASP REVIEW (SPOILER FREE)

NOTE: As my first review here I just wanted to give you an idea of what to expect. I want to stay as far away from spollers as possible, so I won't be doing the typical deep-dive into the story you see from a lot of reviewers. I don't want to break apart the entire film and give you my opinion, I want to review it on a very surface level that gives you a clear view of how I feel about it, without ruining it for you.

I have to be honest. Apart from Infinity War, the last couple of Marvel movies haven't really done it for me the way they used to. Black Panther was okay, but too long, boring, and by the numbers (*Oh hey, the hero fights a bad version of himself at the end, yet again*). Spider-Man Homecoming didn't have an interesting villain, had uninteresting characters, and I'd argue has no real climax. Not to mention it breaks the MCU timeline within the first 5 minutes... Thor Ragnarok was good, but didn't really feel like a Thor movie, which kind of bummed me out. Overall, I was looking forward to Ant-Man and the Wasp mostly due to how surprised I was by how much I liked the first movie. It was funny, had a great cast, told a shockingly interesting story, and I was ready for a follow-up. Ant-Man and the Wasp is not only a worthy follow-up, but one of the better outings we've seen from Marvel recently.

Ant-Man picks up with a recap of what happened to the original Ant-Man, Hank Pym, and his wife Janet Van Dyne, the original Wasp. After going sub-atomic in order to stop a Soviet nuclear missile, Janet is trapped in the Quantum realm. Fast-forward 30 years, and we find ourselves with Paul Rudd's Ant-Man, Scott Lang. No longer owning the suit, and serving two years of house-arrest following the events of Civil War, we get a gimpse into how Scott has been passing the time, offering insight into his life as a father, his relationships with those close to him, and

some of his lingering regrets from the past films. The movie starts off slow, but what it lacks in action, it makes up for with heart. We see a changed Scott, who unlike many characters from the MCU, seems to actually be learning and growing from what happened in previous films.

As you might expect, something pops up, and Scott needs to wear the Ant-Man suit once again, though with mixed feelings. Ant-Man and the Wasp does a great job of juggling the duality that comes with Scott this time around. Wearing the suit comes with its risks, but choosing not to might prove riskier. The writers do a great job of making Scott feel human in a way many comic book movies can't quite always seem to manage. We feel for him, and go through his conflicted journey with him due to great acting, and a well-written script.

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
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
